Under his efforts and guidance, M.G.V. started other colleges imparting higher education in the faculties of Arts, Science, Commerce, Law, Pharmacy and Education at Malegaon and later on at Manmad, Yeola, Nashik and Nampur. After his unfortunate and untimely demise, his wife Smt. Pushpatai Hiray devoted her services for the continuance of the work. The institution started new colleges at Saundane, Harsul and Surgana - the remote tribal areas and a Women's college at Malegaon.


* Location of the College *
