## Report

He also gave information about the primary functions of banks, secondary functions, purchase and sale of loans and payment of bills. He also said that the country's economic growth was accelerating due to nationalized banks. Banks launched various loan schemes for the priority sector for BPL families in the country and opened its doors to the general public. Nationalized banks have an important role to play in strengthening the financial position of the people in the rural areas. Banks have been directed to provide loans to all agriculture and agriculture businesses to improve the economic condition of farmers. Therefore, nationalized banks have to supply a large amount of credit to farmers. For this, the bank has to pay the farmers for the customers. After the nationalization of banks, saving of rural people was given priority. Banks have a huge role to play in providing employment opportunities to the unemployed. Nationalized banks have to compete with other private banks. As a result, the functioning of nationalized banks has recently improved. After globalization, nationalized banks have greatly improved their operations, so the role of nationalized banks in the economic development of the country is definitely very important. Most of the banking services in rural areas are provided only by nationalized banks as private banks operate for profit only. Therefore, their branches in rural areas are nominal, he added.
